**Primary Narrative By Jayson Page, 01/22/26 02:55**

Shift Commander: Lieutenant Wells  
Street Supervisor: Sergeant Webber  
Date: 1/22/2026  
Time: 0029 hours

On the above date and time, I was assigned to 204 as the downtown unit in fully marked Portsmouth Police Department cruiser #39 and wearing a full police uniform. I was traveling out bound on Market Street when I observed a SUV in the left lane repeatedly going over the white dotted lines into the right lane. At one point there was an 18-wheeler in the right lane, the SUV did swerve over the dotted line coming close to colliding with the 18-wheeler. The SUV then over corrected and swerved back into their lane then going over the yellow solid line. I activated my cruiser lights and conducted a traffic stop on the on-ramp for I-95 South by Market Street. The vehicle was a Black Ford Explorer NH Reg: 406 820. The operator was later identified as STEVEN LEE, DOB [REDACTED]

After I approached the vehicle, I explained my reason for pulling him over. While speaking to Steven I observed an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle. Steven stated he was coming from the downtown tonight and was heading home. I asked if he had any drinks while he was out and he stated yes. I returned to my vehicle and had dispatch run his driver license for me. After I returned to his vehicle, I expressed my concerns and asked if he would be willing to participate in SFST's. He complied. Before conducting SFST's I checked the area for debris and to make sure the area was safe. It was snowing and the ground had a dusting of snow on it. There were no other debris. It was also cold with a slight breeze.

**SFST:**

I asked Steven if he had any head injuries, he stated no. He stated he was not on any medications and was not a diabetic. He was also not wearing any glasses at the time of SFST's. I used a pen as my stimulus and confirmed he could see the pen. Steven stated he could. While conducting the HGN I could smell an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from Steven's breath.

**HGN: 4 out of 6 clues**

I checked for pupils of equal size, equal tracking and for resting nystagmus. There were no issues. Steven's eyes were red and glossy. I started with his left eye. I checked for lack of smooth pursuit in each eye. Steven had nystagmus in

both eyes. I then checked for distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation. There was nystagmus in both eyes. Following that, I checked for onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in each eye. I did not observe nystagmus. I then checked for vertical gaze nystagmus. There was no VGN. During this test, Steven was complaining that the snow kept getting into his eyes. He did move his head a few times while trying to follow the stimulus, so I had to remind him to only use his eyes.

Walk and Turn: 3 out of 8 clues

I instructed Steven on how to get into the starting position. After getting into the starting position I advised him not to get out of it until he told to do so. While I was explaining the rest of the instructions for the test, Steven did lose his balance and took a step with his right foot. Around the 5th and 6th step Steven moved his arms while trying to maintain his balance. There were multiple steps throughout this test where Steven would do a foot tap and guide his lead foot into place to make sure, he was heel to toe. Steven took the proper number of steps and conducted the proper turn. The road was wet and slippery. There was a slight downhill slope while on his first iteration of 9 steps then uphill slope on his last 9 steps.

One Leg Stand:

After explaining the instructions to Steven, he had no questions. I had to remind Steven to make sure his foot was parallel with the ground. Around 15 seconds Steven did start to sway, and his left arm slightly moved away from the side of his body. Steven did look at his foot the whole and counted correctly.

After completing the SFST's, I informed Steven he was under arrest. He was handcuffed behind his back. The handcuffs were checked for proper fit and double locked. He was searched incident to arrest. Steven was secured in my cruiser. Steven was very respectful and complied with all steps throughout this process. Steven was transported back to the booking room at the PD.

At the PD I read ALS form #483877 to Steven. I requested a breath test, but he refused. Steven requested the services of a bail commissioner and Paula Tate-Moreau was contacted. Steven was given PR bail with a court date of 1/28/2026 at 0800 hours at the Portsmouth District Court. He was released to Meghan Proctor, DOB 8/25/1979. Steven's vehicle was towed by National Wrecker. Again, during the booking process at the PD, Steven was very respectful and compliant.

## **Supplemental Narrative By Ian Efstathiou, 01/22/26 04:26**

On Wednesday, January 21, 2026, I was assigned to Patrol beat 206A from 2100 to 0300 hours. At approximately 0030 hours I responded to the Interstate 95 South on ramp at Market St, to assist Officer Page with a traffic stop.

The operator was subsequently arrested for DUI and transported back to PPD by Officer Page.

I remained on scene to complete a tow inventory and await National Wrecker.

All items removed from the vehicle were inventoried and submitted into PPD Evidence for safekeeping.

At approximately 0410 hours, all items held for safe keeping were released to Detective Sean Wilton of UNH PD.

This concludes my involvement.



The defendant shall be held pending trial. The Court finds probable cause that the person violated the conditions of his or her bail for any of the crimes listed in RSA 597:2, III(c).

Preventive detention without bail: Pursuant to RSA 597:2, IX, the Court finds probable cause to believe that the person poses a danger to another, after an arraignment for an offense listed in RSA 173-B:1, I, or charged with violation of a protective order issued under RSA 458:16, III.

Bail shall convert to personal recognizance bail upon acceptance into a residential treatment program.

Bail shall revert to  Personal Recognizance  \$ \_\_\_\_\_ Cash  Preventive Detention if the defendant is discharged from the program for any reason, other than successful completion of the program.

(b) Withhold any testimony, information, document or thing; or  
(c) Elude legal process summoning them to provide evidence; or  
(d) Absent themselves from any proceeding or investigation to which they have been summoned;

II. They commit any unlawful act in retaliation for anything done by another in their capacity as witness or informant; or  
III. They solicit, accept or agree to accept any benefit in consideration of them doing any of the things specified in paragraph I.
